Clark, Hoversten, Tewfik named to Board of Medicine

DES MOINES, IA – Governor Terry Branstad and Lieutenant Governor Kim Reynolds have announced the appointments of Diane Clark, Lake Mills, Greg Hoversten, D.O., Sioux City, and Hamed Tewfik, M.D., Iowa City, to the Iowa Board of Medicine.

The appointees will begin their three-year terms on May 1, pending confirmation by the Iowa Senate. Clark is a physician services administrator for Mayo Health System's clinic in Albert Lea, Minn.- Hoversten is an emergency room physician. Tewfik is a radiation oncologist.

They will succeed Board members Paul Thurlow, Dubuque, Janice Galli, D.O., Sioux City, and Rodney Zeitler, M.D., Iowa City, whose terms expire on April 30.

The 10-member Board of Medicine licenses and regulates physicians and acupuncturists. The Board is composed of seven physicians and three public members.
