Clark, Tewfik, Wilson appointed to Board of Medicine

DES MOINES, IA – Governor Terry Branstad and Lieutenant Governor Kim Reynolds have appointed three members to the Iowa Board of Medicine.

Diane Clark, Lake Mills – a public member of the Board, she is a retired physician services administrator. She was appointed to the Board in 2011 and reappointed in 2014.

Hamed Tewfik, M.D., of Iowa City - a physician member of the Board, he is a radiation oncologist at the Iowa City Cancer Treatment Center. He was appointed to the Board in 2011 and reappointed in 2014.

Brian Wilson, D.O., Spencer – A physician member of the Board, he will succeed Ronald Cheney, D.O., who did not seek reappointment. Dr. Wilson, a 1984 graduate of Kirksville College of Osteopathic Medicine, is an Obstetrician-Gynecologist and has been licensed in Iowa since 1996.

The appointments, which must be confirmed by the Iowa Senate, are for three years effective May 1.

The 10-member Board licenses and regulates physicians and acupuncturists. The Board is composed of seven physicians and three public members.
