**STATEMENT OF CHARGES and SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT  
(combined)**

**COMES NOW** the Iowa Board of Medicine (Board), and  
Joseph E. Bergstrom, D.O., (Respondent) on July 10, 2008, and pursuant to  
Iowa Code sections 17A.10(2) and 272C.3(4)(2007), file this combined Statement of  
Charges, and Settlement Agreement.

**STATEMENT OF CHARGES**

1. Respondent was issued Iowa medical license number 03192 on October 12, 1998.
- 2 Respondent's Iowa medical license is active and will next expire on January 1, 2009.
3. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code chapters 147,148 and 272C.

## COUNT I

4. Respondent is charged pursuant to Iowa Code section 148.6(e) and 653 IAC 23.1(21) with knowingly aiding, assisting, procuring, or advising a person to unlawfully practice medicine or Iowa in violation of the laws and rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa.

### STATEMENT OF MATTERS ASSERTED

5. Respondent serves as the director of a family practice resident training program in Bettendorf, Iowa.

6. The Board alleges that Respondent inappropriately permitted a resident to participate in the family practice resident training program without an Iowa medical license in violation of the laws and rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa.

### SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

7. **CITATION AND WARNING:** Respondent is hereby **CITED** for inappropriately permitting a resident to participate in the family practice resident training program without an Iowa medical license in violation of the laws and rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa. Respondent is hereby **WARNED** that violating the laws and rules governing the practice of medicine in the future may result in further formal disciplinary action against his Iowa medical license.

8. **CIVIL PENALTY:** Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of **\$2,500**. The civil penalty shall be paid within twenty (20) days of the date of this Order and shall be made payable to the Treasurer of Iowa, and mailed to the Executive Director of the Board. The civil penalty shall be deposited into the State General Fund.

9. Respondent shall obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa.


10. Respondent voluntarily submits this Order to the Board for consideration.

11. This Order constitutes the resolution of a contested case proceeding.

12. In the event Respondent violates or fails to comply with any of the terms or conditions of this Order, the Board may initiate action to suspend or revoke Respondent's Iowa medical license or to impose other license discipline as authorized in Iowa Code chapters 148 and 272 and 653 IAC 24.


13. This Order is subject to approval by the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Order, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.
