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**STATEMENT OF CHARGES AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT  
(Combined)**

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COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medicine (Board), and Keith O. Bodrero, D.O., (Respondent), on March 8, 2013, and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10(2) and 272C.3(4), enter into this combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement.

**STATEMENT OF CHARGES**

1. Respondent was issued Iowa medical license no. 02752 on October 13, 1992.
2. Respondent's Iowa medical license went inactive due to non-renewal on February 1, 2012.
3. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code Chapters 147, 148 and 272C.

## COUNT I

4. **DISCIPLINE BY ANOTHER LICENSING AUTHORITY:** Respondent is charged pursuant to Iowa Code section 148.6(2)(d) for having a license to practice medicine revoked or suspended, or having other disciplinary action taken by a licensing authority of another state, territory, or country. A certified copy of the record or order of suspension, revocation, or disciplinary action is prima facie evidence.

### STATEMENT OF MATTERS ASSERTED

5. Respondent is an Iowa-licensed physician who practices general medicine in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

6. On April 8, 2010, Respondent entered into a Stipulation and Final Agency Order with the Colorado Board of Medical Examiners (Colorado Board). The Colorado Board concluded that Respondent provided a patient with an inadequate informed consent form relating to alternative medicine and failed to refer the patient to a cardiologist and neurologist when her symptoms necessitated such referral between July 2007 and January 2008. Respondent completed a comprehensive clinical competency evaluation at the Center for Personalized Education for Physicians (CPEP) in Denver, Colorado, on May 27-28, 2010. CPEP noted deficiencies in Respondent's medical knowledge, clinical judgment and reasoning, patient care documentation, and communication. The Colorado Board issued Respondent a Letter of Admonition and ordered him to complete a CPEP supervised education program. On April 10, 2012, the Colorado Board terminated the April 8, 2010, Stipulation and Final Agency Order and restored his Colorado medical license to active an unrestricted status.

## SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

7. **CITATION AND WARNING:** Respondent is hereby **CITED** for being disciplined by the Colorado Board of Medical Examiners in violation of the laws and rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa. Respondent is hereby **WARNED** that failure to conform to the prevailing standard of care or violating the laws and rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa in the future may result in further disciplinary action, including suspension or revocation of his Iowa medical license.

8. Respondent voluntarily submits this Order to the Board for consideration.

9. This Order constitutes the resolution of a contested case proceeding.

10. By entering into this Order, Respondent voluntarily waives any rights to a contested case hearing on the allegations contained in the Statement of Charges and waives any objections to the terms of this Order.

11. Respondent shall obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa.

12. Respondent understands that by entering into this combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement, Respondent cannot obtain a copy of the investigative file. Pursuant to Iowa Code section 272C.6(4), a copy of the investigative file may only be provided to a licensee after a Statement of Charges is filed but before the final resolution of those charges.

13. Respondent understands that the Board is required by Federal law to report this Order to the National Practitioner Data Bank and Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank.

14. The Order becomes a public record available for inspection and copying upon execution in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code Chapters 17A, 22 and 272C.


15. This Order is subject to approval by the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Order, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.
