NOTICE OF SATISFACTION OF STIPULATED LICENSURE ORDER

COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medicine (Board) and on December 11, 2015, files this Notice of Satisfaction of Stipulated Licensure Order.

1. **Application for an Iowa Resident Physician License:** On May 15, 2003, Applicant submitted an application for an Iowa resident physician license.
2. **Notice of Denial of License:** On September 3, 2003, the Board issued a Notice of Denial of License. The Board received information which indicates that Applicant completed residency training in internal medicine at Louisiana State University School of Medicine from July 2001 through June 2002 and in social medicine at Montefiore Medical Center from July 2002 through June 2003. The Board determined that Applicant failed to report this training on his application for an Iowa resident physician license.
3. **Request for Reconsideration of the Notice License Denial:** On November 26, 2003, Applicant filed a Request for Reconsideration of the Notice License Denial.

4. **Stipulated Licensure Order:** On February 26, 2004, the Board issued a Stipulated Licensure Order withdrawing the Denial of License and Applicant agreed to complete certain terms and conditions, including additional post-graduate training at a program accredited by the Board, prior to seeking Iowa medical licensure in the future.

5. **Request for Withdrawal of Stipulated Licensure Order:** On October 28, 2015, Applicant submitted a Request for Withdrawal of the Stipulated Licensure Order. Applicant submitted documentation demonstrating completion of the following:

- A. **Preliminary Surgery Internship:** Respondent successfully completed a preliminary surgery internship at Nassau University Medical Center in East Meadow, New York, from July 1, 2004, through June 30, 2005.
- B. **Internal Medicine Residency Training Program:** Respondent successfully completed the internal medicine residency training program at New York Medical College in Valhalla, New York, from July 1, 2006, through June 30, 2009.
- C. **Board Certification in Internal Medicine:** Respondent successfully passed the internal medicine board certification exam for the American Board of Internal Medicine in 2009.
- D. **Medical Oncology Fellowship Training:** Respondent successfully completed residency training in medical oncology at McGill University in Montreal, Canada, from July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2011.
- E. **Professional/Problem Based Ethics (PROBE) Program:** Respondent successfully completed the PROBE professional ethics program.

THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Board issues this Notice of Satisfaction of Stipulated Licensure Order recognizing that Respondent has successfully completed significant additional post-graduate training at a program accredited by the Board and may seek Iowa medical licensure in the future.

STIPULATED LICENSURE ORDER

COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medical Examiners and the Applicant and file this Stipulated Licensure Order. *February 26, 2004.*

1. On May 15, 2003, Applicant filed an Application for an Iowa resident medical license.
2. On September 3, 2003, the Iowa Board of Medical Examiners issued a Notice of Denial of License. The Board determined that Applicant engaged in fraud in procuring a license and knowingly made misleading, deceptive, untrue or fraudulent representations in the license application process in violation of the laws and rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa.
3. On November 26, 2003, Applicant filed a Request for Reconsideration of the License Denial.

LICENSE DENIAL STIPULATION

4. The Board hereby withdraws the Denial of License on appeal under the following terms and conditions:

A. Prior to seeking medical licensure in the State of Iowa in the future, Applicant must successfully complete a competency evaluation at one of the following programs:

(1). Physician Assessment and Clinical Education Program (P.A.C.E),
University of California, San Diego Medical Center

(2) Center for Professional Education for Physicians (CPEP)

Respondent shall cause a report to be sent to the Board at the conclusion of the evaluation. Respondent shall fully comply with all recommendations made by the evaluating program.

or

B. Applicant shall receive an Iowa resident physician license with the agreement that he will not be eligible for a permanent Iowa medical license unless he successfully completes at least three (3) progressive years of post-graduate training in a single specialty at a program accredited by the Board as established in 653 IAC 9.3(1)(d)(3).

and

TERMS OF FUTURE LICENSURE

C. Should the Board choose to grant Applicant a license in the future, the license shall be granted subject to the following terms and conditions:

(1) Applicant shall receive the following Citation and Warning:

Respondent is hereby **CITED** for failing to provide complete, accurate and truthful information while attempting to procure an Iowa resident physician medical license. Respondent is hereby **WARNED** that engaging in such conduct in the future may result in further disciplinary action, including suspension or revocation of his Iowa medical license.

(2) Applicant must pay a \$5,000 civil penalty.

(3) Applicant must successfully complete the Professional / Problem Based Ethics (PROBE) program sponsored by the Ethics Group, LLC, of Summit, New Jersey. Respondent shall cause a report to be sent to the Board at the conclusion of the program.
