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STIPULATED ORDER

COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medicine (Board), and Malik E. Juweid, M.D., (Respondent), on September 11th, 2012, and enter into this Stipulated Order.

1. Respondent was issued Iowa medical license No. 33812 on November 2, 2000.
2. Respondent's Iowa medical license is active and will expire on July 1, 2013.
3. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code Chapters 147, 148 and 272C.

4. Respondent is an Iowa-license physician who formerly practiced nuclear medicine in Iowa City, Iowa.

5. On November 18, 2011, the Board found cause to issue a Confidential Evaluation Order requiring Respondent to complete a comprehensive physical, neuropsychological, mental health, unprofessional conduct and/or disruptive behavior evaluation pursuant to Iowa Code section 272C.9(1) due to concerns that Respondent engaged in a pattern of unprofessional conduct and/or disruptive behavior.

6. Respondent filed an Objection contesting the allegations in the Confidential Evaluation Order.

7. Respondent has informed the Board that he has moved out of the country and does not intend to practice medicine under his Iowa medical license at this time. Respondent requested that the Board stay enforcement of the Confidential Evaluation Order if he agrees not to practice medicine under his Iowa medical license.


8. Respondent agrees not to engage in any aspect of the practice medicine under his Iowa medical license until he completes a comprehensive physical, neuropsychological, mental health, unprofessional conduct and/or disruptive behavior evaluation pursuant to Iowa Code section 272C.9(1) at a Board-approved assessment program and ensures that an evaluation report is forwarded to the Board directly from the assessment program. Respondent is responsible for all cost associated with the evaluation.


9. The Board agrees to stay enforcement of the Confidential Evaluation Order in this matter as long as Respondent fully complies with the terms and conditions established in this Stipulated Order.

10. Respondent reserves the right to a hearing before the Board on his Objection to the Confidential Evaluation Order, should he elect to contest the order in the future.

11. In the event Respondent violates or fails to comply with any of the terms or conditions of this Order, the Board may initiate action to suspend or revoke Respondent's Iowa medical license or to impose other license discipline as authorized in Iowa Code Chapters 148 and 272 and 653 IAC 12.2.


- 12. Respondent voluntarily submits this Order to the Board for consideration.
- 13. This Order is subject to approval by the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Order, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.
- 14. This Stipulated Order is a public record and is available to the public.
