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**STATEMENT OF CHARGES AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT  
(Combined)**

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COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medicine (Board), and Dennis S. Jones, M.D., (Respondent), on June 6, 2014, and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10(2) and 272C.3(4) enter into this combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement to resolve this matter.

**STATEMENT OF CHARGES**

1. Respondent was issued Iowa medical license no. 20591 on July 1, 1977.
2. Respondent's Iowa medical license is active and will next expire on December 1, 2014.
3. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code chapters 147, 148 and 272C.

## COUNT I

4. **Unethical or Unprofessional Conduct:** Respondent is charged pursuant to Iowa Code sections 147.55(3) and 272C.10(3), and 653 IAC sections 23.1(4), with engaging in unethical or unprofessional conduct. Engaging in unethical or unprofessional conduct includes, but is not limited to, the committing by a licensee of an act contrary to honesty, justice or good morals, whether the same is committed in the course of the licensee's practice or otherwise and whether committed within this state or elsewhere.

### STATEMENT OF MATTERS ASSERTED

5. **Practice Setting:** Respondent is an Iowa-licensed physician who formerly practiced pediatric medicine in Council Bluffs, Iowa. Respondent has not engaged in the practice of medicine since May, 2013.

6. **Criminal Charges:** On May 20, 2013, Respondent was charged with the crime of Second Degree Sexual Abuse for engaging in sex acts with a person under the age of twelve, to-wit, a five year old female, in violation of Iowa Code section 709.3(2). Resolution of the charges is pending.

### SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

7. **VOLUNTARY SURRENDER:** Respondent voluntarily surrenders his Iowa medical license to resolve this matter.

8. Respondent voluntarily submits this Order to the Board for consideration.

9. Respondent agrees that the State's counsel may present this Order to the Board for consideration.

10. This Order constitutes the resolution of a contested case proceeding.

11. By entering into this Order, Respondent understands that he has a right to legal counsel in this matter, voluntarily waives any rights to a contested case hearing on the allegations in the Statement of Charges, and waives any objections to the terms of this Order.


12. Respondent understands that by entering into this combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement, Respondent cannot obtain a copy of the investigative file. Pursuant to Iowa Code section 272C.6(4), a copy of the investigative file may only be provided to a licensee after a Statement of Charges is filed but before the final resolution of those charges.

13. Respondent understands that the Board is required by Federal law to report this Order to the National Practitioner Data Bank.

14. The Order becomes a public record available for inspection and copying upon execution in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code Chapters 17A, 22 and 272C.

15. This Order is subject to approval of the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Order it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

16. The Board's approval of this Order shall constitute a **Final Order** of the Board.
