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CONSENT AGREEMENT

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COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medicine (Board) and Esteban Olivera Alemar, M.D. (Applicant) on December 8, 2014, and enter into this Consent Agreement for the issuance of a permanent Iowa medical license subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Applicant is hereby granted permanent Iowa medical license no. MD-42242.
2. On June 11, 2014, Applicant submitted an application for a permanent Iowa medical license.
3. **Florida Disciplinary Action:** On August 16, 2004, Applicant entered into a Consent Agreement with the Florida Board of Medicine (Florida Board). The Florida Board alleged that Applicant failed to conform to minimal standards of acceptable medical practice when he failed to appreciate the seriousness of a patient's chest pain, history, and/or abnormal test results; failed to admit the patient to the hospital for further testing and monitoring; failed to have the patient evaluated by a cardiologist; and failed to arrange appropriate follow-up with a cardiologist upon discharging the patient. The

Florida Board issued Applicant a Letter of Concern; imposed a \$5,000 fine; ordered Applicant to complete of five (5) hours of continuing medical education in the area of hypertrophic cardiomyopathy; and required Applicant to reimburse administrative costs. Applicant successfully completed all remediation and paid the fine.

4. **CITATION AND WARNING:** Applicant is hereby **CITED** for being disciplined by the Florida Board and for failing to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable medical practice in his treatment of a patient with chest pain. Applicant is hereby **WARNED** that failing to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable medical practice and/or violating the laws and rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa in the future may result in further disciplinary action against his Iowa medical license.

5. Respondent voluntarily submits this Order to the Board for consideration.

6. Respondent agrees that the State's counsel may present this Order to the Board for consideration.

7. By entering into this Order, Respondent understands that he has the right to legal counsel in this matter and waives any objections to the terms of this Order.


8. Respondent shall obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa.

9. Respondent understands that the Board is required by Federal law to report this action to the National Practitioner Data Bank.

10. This Order becomes a public record available for inspection and copying upon execution in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code Chapters 17A, 22 and 272C.

11. This Order is subject to approval of the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Order it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

12. The Board's approval of this Order shall constitute a **Final Order** of the Board.




