CONSENT AGREEMENT

COME NOW the Iowa Board of Medicine (Board) and Kenneth Quenneville, M.D. (Applicant) on Oct. 21, 2011, and enter into this Consent Agreement for the issuance of a permanent Iowa medical license subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Applicant is hereby granted Iowa permanent medical license no. 39876, to practice medicine and surgery in Iowa.
2. Applicant currently practices emergency medicine in Memphis, Missouri.
3. On February 7, 2011, Applicant applied for a permanent Iowa medical license
4. On or about February 16, 1990, the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners suspended Applicant's Texas medical license due to substance abuse. On or about June 28, 1991, the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners reinstated Applicant's Texas medical license and placed him on probation for a period of five years subject to substance abuse counseling and monitoring. On or about August 20, 1993, the Texas

State Board of Medical Examiners terminated the terms and conditions placed on Applicant's Texas medical license.

5. On or about April 4, 1998, the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners suspended Applicant's Texas medical license due to substance abuse, stayed the suspension and placed him on probation for a period of five years subject to substance abuse counseling and monitoring. On or about October 4, 2002, Applicant agreed to pay a \$5,000 administrative penalty for failing to fully comply with the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners' drug testing program. On or about April 4, 2003, the terms and conditions of probation placed on Applicant's Texas medical license due to substance abuse automatically expired. On or about October 10, 2003, Applicant agreed to pay a \$1,000 administrative penalty for failing to fully comply with the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners' drug testing program while he was on probation in October 2002.

6. Applicant has maintained his sobriety for over ten years.

7. **CITATION AND WARNING:** Applicant is hereby **CITED** for being disciplined by the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners for engaging in substance abuse. Applicant is hereby **WARNED** that such conduct in the future may result in further disciplinary action, including suspension or revocation of his Iowa medical license.

8. Applicant shall obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa.

9. This Consent Agreement constitutes the resolution of a contested case proceeding.

10. Applicant voluntarily submits this Consent Agreement to the Iowa Board for consideration.


11. By entering into this Consent Agreement, Applicant voluntarily waives any right to a contested case hearing in this matter.

12. This Consent Agreement is subject to approval of the Iowa Board. If the Iowa Board fails to approve the Order, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

13. The Iowa Board's approval of this Consent Agreement shall constitute a **FINAL ORDER** of the Iowa Board.
