**STATEMENT OF CHARGES and SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT
(combined)**

COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medicine (the Board), and Vladimir Redko, M.D., (Respondent), on August 28, 2008, and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10(2) and 272C.3(4) (2007), file this combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement to resolve this pending disciplinary matter.

1. Respondent was issued Iowa medical license no. 25355 on March 25, 1986.
2. Respondent's Iowa medical license is active and will next expire on May 1, 2010.
3. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code chapters 147, 148 and 272C.

COUNT I

4. Respondent is charged pursuant to Iowa Code section 148.6(2)(d) with being disciplined by the medical licensing authority of another state.

STATEMENT OF MATTERS ASSERTED

5. Respondent is an Iowa licensed physician who practices pain medicine in Houston, Texas.

6. On September 17, 2007, Respondent was disciplined by the Texas Medical Board for failing to maintain appropriate medical records when he failed to document focused patient examinations and medical necessity for five patients. Respondent is required to have a Board-approved monitor review his medical practice from January 1, 2008, thru December 31, 2008. He is also required to complete at least twelve (12) hours of Board-approved Continuing Medical Education (CME) in the area of record keeping and/or risk management and pay a \$2,000 administrative penalty.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

7. **CITATION AND WARNING:** Respondent is hereby **CITED** for failing to maintain appropriate medical records when he failed to document focused patient examinations and medical necessity for five patients. Respondent is hereby **WARNED** that evidence of such conduct in the future may result in further formal disciplinary action, including revocation of his Iowa medical license.

8. **COMPLIANCE WITH TEXAS ORDER:** Respondent shall fully comply with the terms and conditions established by the Texas Board. Respondent shall provide the Iowa Board documentation demonstrating his completion of the requirements established by the Texas Board.

9. **CIVIL PENALTY:** Respondent shall be assessed a civil penalty in the amount of **\$1,000**. The civil penalty shall be paid within twenty days of the date of this Order and shall be paid by delivery of a check or money order, payable to the Treasurer of Iowa, to the executive director of the Board. The civil penalty shall be deposited into the State General Fund.

10. By entering into this Order Respondent voluntarily waives any rights to a contested case hearing on the allegations contained in the Statement of Charges, and waives any objections to the terms of this Settlement Agreement.

11. Respondent voluntarily submits this Order to the Board for consideration.


12. This Order constitutes the resolution of a contested case proceeding.

14. The Board's approval of this Order shall constitute a **FINAL ORDER** of the Board.




