**STATEMENT OF CHARGES and SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT
(Combined)**

COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medicine (Board) and Robert W. Reid, M.D., (Respondent), on July 12, 2012, and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10(2) and 272C.3(4), enter into this combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement.

STATEMENT OF CHARGES

1. Respondent was issued Iowa medical license no. 28170 on June 12, 1991.
2. Respondent's Iowa medical license went inactive due to nonrenewal on December 1, 1997.
3. On April 12, 2012, Respondent submitted an application to reinstate his Iowa medical license.
4. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code chapters 147, 148 and 272C.

COUNT I

5. **Disciplinary Action by Another Licensing Authority:**

Respondent is charged pursuant to Iowa Code section 148.6(2)(d) for having disciplinary action taken against him by a licensing authority of another state.

STATEMENT OF THE MATTERS ASSERTED

6. Respondent is an Iowa-licensed physician who currently practices critical care medicine in Lees Summit, Missouri.

7. On March 11, 2002, Respondent was disciplined by the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (Kansas Board) for substance abuse and professional misconduct. Respondent had restrictions placed on his anesthesiology practice and his ability prescribe and administer controlled substances under his Kansas medical license. On October 23, 2003, the restrictions on Respondent's Kansas medical license were terminated and he was ordered to continue substance abuse monitoring by the Medical Advocacy Program of the Kansas Medical Society for a period of five years.

8. On January 12, 2004, Respondent entered into a Consent Order with the Missouri State Board of Registration for the Healing Arts (Missouri Board). Respondent was disciplined for failing to disclose his substance abuse history on a renewal application. Respondent was placed on probation for a period of five years subject to substance abuse monitoring by the Missouri State Medical Associations Physician Health Program. On January 12, 2009, the terms of probation placed on Respondent's Missouri medical license were terminated.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

9. **CITATION AND WARNING:** Respondent is hereby **CITED** for being disciplined by the Kansas Board and the Missouri Board in violation of the laws and rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa. Respondent is hereby **WARNED** that being disciplined by another state licensing board in the future may result in further formal disciplinary action against his Iowa medical license.

10. **CIVIL PENALTY:** Respondent shall pay a **\$1,000 civil penalty** within twenty (20) days of the date of this order. The civil penalty shall be made payable to the Treasurer of Iowa, and mailed to the executive director of the Board. The civil penalty shall be deposited into the State General Fund.

11. Respondent shall obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa.

12. Respondent voluntarily submits this Order to the Board for consideration.

13. This Order constitutes the resolution of a contested case proceeding.

14. Respondent understands that by entering into this combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement, Respondent cannot obtain a copy of the investigative file. Pursuant to Iowa Code section 272C.6(4), a copy of the investigative file may only be provided to a licensee after a Statement of Charges is filed but before the final resolution of those charges.

15. By entering into this Order, Respondent voluntarily waives any rights to a contested case hearing on the allegations contained in the Statement of Charges and waives any objections to the terms of this Settlement Agreement.

16. This Order is subject to approval by the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Settlement Agreement and Final Order, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.


17. The Board's approval of this Order shall constitute a **Final Order** of the Board.
