**STATEMENT OF CHARGES AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT
(Combined)**

COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medicine (Board), and Dennis F. Rolek, D.O., (Respondent), on June 28, 2013, and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10(2) and 272C.3(4) enter into this combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement to resolve this matter.

STATEMENT OF CHARGES

1. Respondent was issued Iowa medical license no. 01630 on July 1, 1977.
2. Respondent's Iowa medical license is active and will next expire on September 1, 2013.
3. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code chapters 147, 148 and 272C.

COUNT I

4. **Physical or Mental Impairment:** Respondent is charged pursuant to Iowa Code section 148.6(2)(h) and 653 IAC 23.1(8) with suffering from mental or physical condition. A mental or physical condition includes any physical, neurological or mental condition which may impair a physician's ability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety.

STATEMENT OF MATTERS ASSERTED

5. Respondent is an Iowa-licensed physician who formerly practiced family medicine in Des Moines, Iowa, and emergency medicine in several locations in Iowa.

6. Recently, the Board received information which indicates that Respondent suffers from a physical and/or neurological condition which impairs his ability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

7. **VOLUNTARY SURRENDER:** Respondent voluntarily surrenders his Iowa medical license to resolve this matter.

8. Respondent shall obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa.

9. Respondent voluntarily submits this Order to the Board for consideration.

10. By entering into this Order, Respondent understands that he has a right to legal counsel in this matter, voluntarily waives any rights to a contested case hearing on the allegations in the Statement of Charges, and waives any objections to the terms of this Order.

11. Respondent understands that by entering into this combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement, Respondent cannot obtain a copy of the investigative file. Pursuant to Iowa Code section 272C.6(4), a copy of the investigative file may only be provided to a licensee after a Statement of Charges is filed but before the final resolution of those charges.

12. Respondent agrees that the State's counsel may present this Order to the Board.

13. This Order is subject to approval of the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Order it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

14. The Board's approval of this Order shall constitute a **Final Order** of the Board.

COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medicine (Board) and Dennis F. Rolek, D.O. (Respondent) on August 31, 2012, and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10 and 272C.3(4), enter into this Stipulated Order.


1. Respondent was issued Iowa license no. 06130 on July 1, 1977.
2. Respondent's Iowa medical license is active and will next expire on September 1, 2013.
3. Respondent is an Iowa-licensed physician who practices family medicine in Des Moines, Iowa. Respondent also practices emergency medicine in numerous locations in Iowa.
4. Respondent agrees he shall not engage in any aspect of the practice of medicine until the Board approves his return to the practice of medicine.
5. This Stipulated Order is a public record.
6. Respondent voluntarily submits this Stipulated Order to the Board for

consideration.

7. In the event Respondent violates or fails to comply with any of the terms of this Stipulated Order, the Board may initiate action to suspend or revoke Respondent's Iowa medical license or to impose other license discipline authorized in Iowa Code Chapters 147, 148 and 272 and 653 IAC 23.

8. This Order is subject to approval by the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Order, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

9. The Board's approval of this Order shall constitute a **Final Order** of the Board.
