CONSENT AGREEMENT

COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medicine (Board) and Michael T. Salwitz, M.D. (Applicant) on October 28, 2016, and enter into this Consent Agreement for the issuance of a permanent Iowa medical license subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Applicant is hereby granted permanent Iowa medical license no. MD-43914.
2. On May 21, 2016, Applicant submitted an application for a permanent Iowa medical license.
3. **Arizona Disciplinary Action:** On September 4, 2003, Applicant entered into a Public Consent Agreement for Decree of Censure with the Arizona Medical Board (Arizona Board). The Arizona Board concluded that Applicant failed to appropriately evaluate, diagnose and treat a patient's gastric ulcer, and improperly discharged the patient from the emergency room with deteriorating vital signs. The Arizona Board issued Applicant a Decree of Censure and Applicant agreed to pay a \$1,000 fine. Applicant was subsequently disciplined in Ohio based on the Arizona disciplinary action.

4. **Discipline by Another Licensing Authority:** Pursuant to Iowa Code section 148.6(2)(d) having a license to practice medicine and surgery or osteopathic medicine and surgery revoked or suspended, or having other disciplinary action taken by a licensing authority of another state, territory, or country is grounds for discipline under Iowa law. A certified copy of the order of disciplinary action is prima facie evidence.

5. **CITATION AND WARNING:** Applicant is hereby **CITED** for being disciplined by the Arizona and Ohio Boards for failure to provide appropriate medical care to a single patient. Applicant is hereby **WARNED** that being disciplined by another licensing authority and/or violating the laws and rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa in the future may result in further disciplinary action against his Iowa medical license.

6. Respondent voluntarily submits this Order to the Board for consideration.

7. Respondent agrees that the State's counsel may present this Order to the Board for consideration.

8. By entering into this Order, Respondent understands that he has the right to legal counsel in this matter and waives any objections to the terms of this Order.


9. Respondent shall obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa.

10. Respondent understands that the Board is required by Federal law to report this action to the National Practitioner Data Bank.

11. This Order becomes a public record available for inspection and copying upon execution in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code Chapters 17A, 22 and 272C.

12. This Order is subject to approval of the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Order it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

13. The Board's approval of this Order shall constitute a **Final Order** of the Board.




