**STATEMENT OF CHARGES and SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT
(Combined)**

COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medicine (Board), and Mangil Seo, M.D., (Respondent), on May 17, 2012, and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10(2) and 272C.3(4) enter into this combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement.

STATEMENT OF CHARGES

1. Respondent was issued Iowa medical license no. 19652 on February 19, 1975.
2. Respondent's Iowa medical license will expire on February 1, 2013.
3. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code chapters 147, 148 and 272C.

COUNT I

4. **Professional Incompetency:** Respondent is charged pursuant to Iowa Code sections 147.55(2), 148.6(2)(g) and 272C.10(2) and 653 IAC 23.1(2)(f) for failing to conform to the minimal standard of acceptable and prevailing practice of medicine in Iowa.

STATEMENT OF THE MATTERS ASSERTED

5. Respondent practices general medicine in Des Moines, Iowa.
6. The Board received information which raises serious concerns that Respondent failed to conform to the minimal standard of acceptable and prevailing practice of medicine including, but not limited to, the following:
 - A. Inappropriately prescribing controlled substances to patients.
 - B. Inappropriately dispensing medications to patients.
 - C. Failure to diagnose and treat breast cancer in a timely manner.
 - D. Treating patients with complex psychiatric disorders and other medical conditions which are beyond his training and expertise without making appropriate referrals to specialists.
7. On February 6-7, 2012, Respondent completed a confidential comprehensive clinical competency evaluation and the Board concluded that he is unsafe to practice medicine.
8. Respondent filed an answer in conjunction with this order denying the allegations.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

9. Respondent **voluntarily surrenders** his Iowa medical license (03182) effective May 18, 2012, to resolve this matter.

10. Respondent voluntarily submits this Order to the Board for consideration.

11. This Order constitutes the resolution of a contested case proceeding.

12. Respondent understands that by entering into this combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement, Respondent cannot obtain a copy of the investigative file. Pursuant to Iowa Code section 272C.6(4), a copy of the investigative file may only be provided to a licensee after a Statement of Charges is filed but before the final resolution of those charges.

13. In the event Respondent violates or fails to comply with any of the terms or conditions of this Order, the Board may initiate action to suspend or revoke Respondent's Iowa medical license or to impose other license discipline as authorized in Iowa Code Chapters 148 and 272 and 653 IAC 12.2.

14. By entering into this Order, Respondent voluntarily waives any rights to a contested case hearing on the allegations contained in the Statement of Charges and waives any objections to the terms of this Order.

15. This Order is subject to approval by the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Order, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

16. The Board's approval of this Order shall constitute a **Final Order** of the Board.
