CONSENT AGREEMENT

COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medicine (Board) and Matthew J. Stottle, M.D. (Applicant) on December 24, 2014, and enter into this Consent Agreement for the issuance of a permanent Iowa medical license subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Applicant is hereby granted permanent Iowa medical license no. MD-42271.
2. On June 11, 2014, Applicant submitted an application for a permanent Iowa medical license.
3. **Nebraska Settlement Agreement:** On August 16, 2007, Applicant was issued a probationary temporary medical license by the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services division of Public Health (Nebraska Board) following three alcohol related convictions and a diagnosis of alcohol abuse. The terms of the probationary license included abstention from the personal use of controlled substances and alcohol; submitting to random body fluid screen testing; compliance with all treatment recommendations; and notifying the Nebraska Board of any changes in employment

status. While on probation, Applicant was disciplined by the Nebraska Board. The Nebraska Board determined that Applicant failed to appear for body fluid screen testing on three occasions and on December 28, 2007, Applicant tested positive for alcohol. Applicant's temporary medical permit was censured and he was assessed a \$1,000 fine for violating the terms of probation. Applicant successfully completed the terms of his probation on August 16, 2012.

4. **Illinois Consent Order:** On June 20, 2013, Applicant entered into a Consent Order with the Illinois Department of Financial & Professional Regulation (Illinois Board) based on the disciplinary action taken by the Nebraska Board. The Illinois Board issued Applicant a reprimand.

5. **CITATION AND WARNING:** Applicant is hereby **CITED** for being disciplined by the Nebraska and Illinois Boards for alcohol abuse and violating the terms of his Nebraska probation. Applicant is hereby **WARNED** that substance abuse and/or violating the laws and rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa in the future may result in further disciplinary action against his Iowa medical license.

6. Respondent voluntarily submits this Order to the Board for consideration.

7. Respondent agrees that the State's counsel may present this Order to the Board for consideration.

8. By entering into this Order, Respondent understands that he has the right to legal counsel in this matter and waives any objections to the terms of this Order.

9. Respondent shall obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of medicine in Iowa.

10. Respondent understands that the Board is required by Federal law to report this action to the National Practitioner Data Bank.

11. This Order becomes a public record available for inspection and copying upon execution in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code Chapters 17A, 22 and 272C.

12. This Order is subject to approval of the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Order it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

13. The Board's approval of this Order shall constitute a **Final Order** of the Board.






