STIPULATED ORDER:

AGREEMENT NOT TO PRACTICE MEDICINE

COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Medicine (Board) and Thomas Warren, Jr., M.D. (Respondent) on *September 30*, 2016, and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10 and 272C.3(4), enter into this Stipulated Order.

1. **Iowa Medical License:** Respondent was issued Iowa medical license no. 30923 on November 16, 1995. Respondent's Iowa medical license is active and will next expire on August 1, 2017.

3. **Jurisdiction:** The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code chapters 147, 148 and 272C.

4. **Practice Setting:** Respondent is an Iowa-licensed physician who formerly practiced oncology in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. Respondent has not practiced medicine for over a year.

5. **Health Condition:** Recently, the Board received information which indicates that Respondent suffers from a physical, mental or neuropsychological condition which impairs his ability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety.

6. **Agreement Not to Practice Medicine:** Respondent agrees that he shall not engage in any aspect of the practice of medicine until this matter is resolved and he receives prior written approval from the Board.

7. Respondent voluntarily submits this Stipulated Order to the Board for consideration.

8. Respondent agrees that the State's counsel may present this Stipulated Order to the Board for consideration.

9. Respondent understands that by entering into this Stipulated Order he has a right to legal counsel in this matter and waives any objections to the terms of this Order.

10. Respondent understands that by entering into this Stipulated Order, he cannot obtain a copy of the investigative file. Pursuant to Iowa Code section 272C.6(4), a copy of the investigative file may only be provided to a licensee after a Statement of Charges is filed but before the final resolution of those charges.

11. Respondent understands that the Board is required by Federal law to report this Stipulated Order to the National Practitioner Data Bank.

12. Respondent understands that this Stipulated Order becomes a public record available for inspection and copying upon execution in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code Chapters 17A, 22 and 272C.

13. In the event Respondent violates or fails to comply with any of the terms of this Stipulated Order, the Board may initiate action to suspend or revoke Respondent's Iowa medical license or to impose other license discipline authorized in Iowa Code Chapters 147, 148 and 272 and 653 IAC 23.

14. This Order is subject to approval by the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Order, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

15. The Board's approval of this Order shall constitute a **Final Order** of the Board.
