Executive Director’s Update

Mark Bowden, Executive Director, updated the Board on Executive Orders and Legislation.

The Governor issued an Executive Order regarding rule making. When submitting any new Administrative Rules, an economic impact statement regarding the economic impact the rule would have on the state’s

economic growth and whether it will cost jobs in Iowa. Not sure if this is going to occur prior to the issue of Notice of Intended Action or after the notice. This may slow the administrative rule process. Bowden and other Board Directors are going to schedule a meeting with the legal counsel in the Governor's Office to discuss. The three rules we just noticed wouldn't fall under this order. This will be discussed further at the April meeting.

House File 45 is the first act that has impact on taxpayers. This file contains fundamental issues regarding the status of these Boards and the language about general fund appropriations. Apparently they have put a freeze on out of state travel, state offices, and the expenditure of state funds. We need to know the status of the fee based councils and if any of this is applicable to our Board. A letter has been submitted by the four Boards to the Executive Council asking if this is applicable to these four Boards. The Boards are planning to meet with the Governor's Office Council, to find out what they were thinking as regard to the administrative rule as well as the first act.

The meeting adjourned at 8:10 a.m.
