At 1:02 p.m., Colleen Stockdale, M.D., chair, called the meeting to order. A roll call was taken to establish a quorum. Board members Diane Clark, Ann Gales and Jeffrey Snyder, M.D., were not present. On a motion by Hamed Tewfik, M.D., and a second by Frank Bognanno, the Board unanimously approved the agenda as presented.

Executive Director's report

Mark Bowden, executive director, provided the following updates:

- The process is under way to hire an investigator to fill the position vacated by Ed Knapp. It's likely the new hire will be known by the January 10-11, 2013, Board meeting,
- Russell Bardin, chief investigator, is attending the 21st National Conference on Pharmaceutical and Chemical Diversion this week (November 14-15).
- Ann Gales will attend the Citizen Advocacy Center annual meeting, October 25-26.
- Michael Thompson, D.O., will attend the American Association of Osteopathic Examiners' summit, January 4-5, 2013.

Administrative rules

- On a motion by Joyce Vista-Wayne, M.D., seconded by Hamed Tewfik, M.D., the Board voted unanimously to adopt and file ARC 0176C (653-Chapter 22.5). This rule pertains to a licensee's mandatory reporting obligation of hospital action against a licensee's privileges.
- On a motion by Joyce Vista-Wayne, M.D., seconded by Hamed Tewfik, M.D., the Board voted unanimously to adopt and file ARC0177C (653-Chapter 23.1(48)). This rule pertains to grounds for discipline for a licensee's failure to report hospital action.

Ad hoc committees

- Joyce Vista-Wayne, M.D., chair of the ad hoc committee reviewing the roles of administrative law judges and Alternate members in contested case hearings, reported language has been drafted to amend Iowa Code Chapter 148. On a motion by Hamed Tewfik, M.D., seconded by Julie Perkins, M.D., the Board voted unanimously to seek amendments to Iowa Code Chapter 148 as identified by the ad hoc committee.
- Jeffrey Snyder, M.D., chair of the ad hoc committee reviewing expectations for physicians who supervise physician assistants, was absent. Mr. Bowden briefly reported that the committee met in October, but has not had time to discuss information received in that meeting. He noted that the committee supported more education to Iowa physicians about the existing state laws and rules on supervising physician assistants.

Possible legislation for 2013 General Assembly

In addition to the proposed amendments to Iowa Code Chapter 148, the Board also supported amending Iowa Code Chapter 124 to require physicians and pharmacists to check the Iowa Prescription Drug Monitoring Database before prescribing a controlled substance and/or filing a controlled substance prescription if these health care providers suspect the patient is at risk of abuse or diversion of the controlled substances. On a motion by Greg Hoversten, D.O., seconded by Frank Bognanno, the Board voted unanimously to seek an amendment to Iowa Code Chapter 124.

NowClinic online medical care (telemedicine)

Kent Nebel, director of legal affairs, briefed the Board on NowClinic, a company that provides Internet-based telemedicine services across state lines. NowClinic operates in Minnesota and Wisconsin, and has indicated it may seek additional markets in the Midwest. Mr. Nebel noted the Board's approach to such proposals is to review them individually. He noted that some states are addressing telemedicine through licensure means (a special license for such practices), while other states have put more emphasis on writing laws or rules that define a telemedicine practice and how it will be regulated.

CMS Rules on payment for CRNAs' pain management procedures

Mr. Bowden give the Board a brief update on pending rule changes regarding Medicare reimbursement to certified registered nurse anesthetists who practice certain pain management procedures. He noted that this scope of practice issue remains unsettled in Iowa in part due to a case before the Iowa Supreme Court involving administrative rules that allow CRNAs to supervise fluoroscopy.

Reports

- FSMB Board Attorney Workshop, Nov. 1-2. Kent Nebel, director of legal affairs, and Julie Bussanmas, an assistant attorney general who prosecutes Board cases, attended this annual training. Mr. Nebel said discussions included increasing regulatory issues involving appropriate prescribing for pain management. He noted that Iowa is ahead of most states by already mandating requirements for pain management education. He said some state boards have responsibilities to regulate pain clinics in addition to the physicians who work in these facilities.
- Learning Summit at Center for Personalized Education for Physicians (CPEP), Oct. 29-30. Enforcement monitors Mary Knapp and Shantel Billington attended the summit, which focuses on services provided by CPEP. The Iowa Board makes referrals to CPEP to assess the clinical competency of physicians who are being investigated or who have been assigned to CPEP by a Board order.
- AIM Licensure Conference, Nov. 9-10. Amy Van Maanen, director of licensure, attended this conference in New Orleans. She said topics covered include what's new in state regulations for licensure portability, online education components to help licensees become more familiar with state regulations, and discussions regarding the number of attempts an applicant can take to pass the USMLE.

Licensure

Ms. Van Maanen reported that FSMB should be issuing a report soon regarding maintenance of licensure requirements for clinical inactive physicians. She said a pilot project regarding collecting information from board members about their understanding of MOL has been completed.

The Licensure Committee met today (November 16), and issued 4 permanent medical licenses and 1 acupuncture license, met with a medical licensure applicant to discuss license options, reviewed the USMLE annual report, and discussed a proposal to amend the Board's administrative rules to provide for an licensure renewal fee exemption for physicians who are on active duty in the U.S. armed forces, reserves or national guard.

Iowa Physician Health Committee and Program

Deb Anglin, IPHP coordinator, said the program will be completing its 16th year at the end of 2012. She said Diane O'Connor, Fort Dodge, will be leaving the committee at the end of 2012. Ms. Anglin said Greg Skipper, M.D., a nationally recognized addiction specialist, will present a workshop for the agency on June 26, 2013. She also provided a statistical report on program participants.

Updates on judicial review of cases

Julie Bussanmas, assistant attorney general, provide brief updates on six Board cases that are under judicial review in district and appellate courts.
