

**PRESS RELEASE**  
**IOWA BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS**  
**(October 4, 2005)**

The Iowa Board of Medical Examiners took the following action:

**Eduardo Reveiz, M.D.**, a 67 year-old physician practicing medicine Webster City, Iowa, had formal disciplinary charges filed against his Iowa medical license. The Board charged Dr. Reveiz with engaging in a pattern of professional incompetency and practice harmful or detrimental to the public in his treatment of three patients. The charges allege that Dr. Reveiz failed in two cases to timely diagnose and treat appendicitis and that he failed to timely diagnose and treat testicular torsion in another case. The Board filed disciplinary charges against Dr. Reveiz on two prior occasions. On April 11, 1991, the Board charged Dr. Reveiz with serious quality of care violations in his obstetrical and surgical practice. Dr. Reveiz was permanently prohibited from practicing obstetrics and orthopedic surgery. On September 8, 1994, the Board charged Dr. Reveiz with performing orthopedic surgery in violation of the permanent restriction placed on his license. The Board suspended Dr. Reveiz' for thirty days and ordered him to pay a \$10,000 civil penalty. A hearing is scheduled for October 18, 2005.
