IOWA BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS
(July 31, 2006)

Recently, the Iowa Board of Medical Examiners took the following action:

Neville Q. Crenshaw, D.O., a 52 year-old general practitioner from Kahoka, Missouri, entered into a combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement with the Iowa Board to resolve a pending disciplinary matter. Dr. Crenshaw was disciplined by the Missouri Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs (MBNDD) for technical violations of the laws and rules governing the maintenance and destruction of controlled substances. The MBNDD placed Dr. Crenshaw on probation for a period of two years subject to certain terms and conditions. The Iowa Board reprimanded Dr. Crenshaw for being disciplined by the MBNDD.

Phillip S. Yee, M.D., a 39 year-old surgeon from Decorah, Iowa, entered into a combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement with the Board to resolve a pending disciplinary matter. Dr. Yee was charged with improperly altering a patient's medical records after he mistakenly performed hernia surgery at the wrong site. Dr. Yee was ordered to complete a Board-approved professional ethics program, pay a \$5,000 fine and he received a reprimand.
