



# THE BOARDS THAT REGULATED MEDICAL PRACTICE IN IOWA, 1886-PRESENT

State Board of Medical Examiners, 1886-2007  
State Board of Osteopathic Examiners, 1921-1963  
Iowa Board of Medicine, 2007 – Present

**T**HE 21<sup>st</sup> General Assembly created the State Board of Medical Examiners in 1886 with the Medical Practice Act. Board members were the seven physician members and the secretary (also a physician) of the State Board of Health. Members of the Board of Health were appointed by the Governor to serve for seven years. The Board of Medical Examiners had authority to issue certificates (licenses) to persons who earned degrees (M.D.) from medical schools in “good standing” or to persons without a medical degree if they had been in continuous medical practice in Iowa for at least five years and to those who, not having these qualifications passed a satisfactory examination before the Board. Members of the Board were entitled to a per diem of \$10, and traveling and other necessary expenses.

**❖ The 27<sup>st</sup> General Assembly in 1898 approved the Practice of Osteopathy Act, authorizing the State Board of Medical Examiners to issue medical licenses to persons holding a diploma from school of osteopathy of good repute. It wasn't until May 15, 1902, that the Board issued its first license to an osteopathic physician. The issuance of the license was ordered by the Polk County District Court.**

**❖ The 35th General Assembly in 1913 provided many changes in the membership and organization of the**

**State Board of Health, effective July 1, 1913. The name was changed to the State Board of Health and Medical Examiners. The active membership would consist of four physicians and one sanitary engineer appointed by the Governor and a physician elected by the board members to serve as board secretary. Terms on the board were five years. The five physicians – two doctors of medicine, one doctor of homeopathic medicine and one doctor of eclectic medicine – would now constitute the State Board of Medical Examiners.**

**❖ The 39<sup>th</sup> General Assembly created the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners in 1921 with the Osteopathy Practice Act. The 39<sup>th</sup> General Assembly also changed the number and composition of the members of State Board of Medical Examiners. In the follow year, these Board members would no longer be members of the State Board of Health. Members of the Osteopathic Examiners and Medical Boards were now appointed by the Governor. By 1925, each board would have three members, each appointed to three-year terms. These**

**boards were under the State Board of Health, which also oversaw several newly created examining boards for embalming, nursing, optometry, podiatry and chiropractic.**

**❖ In 1924, The 40<sup>th</sup> General Assembly provided for the consolidation of the offices of the State Board of Health, the State Hotel Inspector and the boards of examiners for medical, osteopathy, chiropractic, dental, embalming, nursing, and optometry into one department to be known as the State Department of Public Health. The new law put all examining boards into a new “Division of Examinations and Licensure” and gave the health department the authority to begin writing administrative rules for the enforcement laws regarding examination and licensure of health professionals.**

❖ **The 55th General Assembly in 1953 increased the size of the Medical Examiners Board from three to five members, each serving for a period of five years. All members had to be licensed medical physicians practicing in Iowa. The new law also established a separate office for the Board with an executive secretary.**

**❖ In 1963, the 60<sup>th</sup> General Assembly abolished the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners and redefined the State Board of Medical Examiners, making it a composite board for licensure and regulation of M.D. and D.O. physicians. The newly constituted State Board of Medical Examiners now had eight members – six medical physicians (M.D.s) and two osteopathic physicians (D.O.s). The board's membership represented the ratio of medical physicians and osteopathic physicians licensed in Iowa.**

**❖ The 65<sup>th</sup> General Assembly in 1975 increased the size of the Medical Examiners Board from eight to nine members, adding two non-physicians who would serve as “public” members of the Board, and reducing the number of medical physicians (M.D.) from six to five. A Board member’s term is three years.**

## **Board Member Milestones**

- ❖ **William S. Robertson, M.D.**, Muscatine was the first president of the State Board of Medical Examiners. He received the Board's first medical license, n-00001, issued on July 9, 1886. Dr. Robertson was the first president of the State Board of Health.
- ❖ **Henry J. Marshall, D.O.**, Des Moines, served as the first president of the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners when the Board was established in 1921.

- ❖ **Walter L. Bierring, M.D.**, Des Moines, served as president of the State Board of Medical Examiners and president of the State Board of Health from 1914 through 1922. He was president of the American Medical Association, 1934-35. He held the appointment of health commissioner for the State of Iowa from 1933 to 1953, and up to the time of his death in 1961, he was director of the Iowa Health Department's division of gerontology, heart and chronic diseases. From 1912 to 1960, he was secretary-treasurer of the Federation of State Medical Boards, and his long-time service with the FSMB is annually recognized with a banquet named in his honor.
- ❖ **Joseph A. McCaffrey**, Davenport, and **Sheila Sidles**, Centerville, were the first public members on the State Board of Medical Examiners. They were appointed in 1975 by Governor Robert Ray.
- ❖ **Cecil L. Peterson, D.O.**, Davenport, was the first osteopathic physician to head the State Board of Medical Examiners. Members of the Board elected Dr. Peterson president of the Board for 1993-1994.
- ❖ **Frank M. Fuller, M.D.**, Keokuk, was president of the Federation of State Medical Boards in 1943. He was a member of the Iowa Board from 1927 to 1942.
- ❖ **Hormoz Rassekh, M.D.**, Council Bluffs, was president of the Federation of State Medical Boards in 1994. He was a member of the Iowa Board from 1985 to 1988.
