Physicians needed for state boards, committees

DES MOINES, IA -- Iowa physicians are needed to serve on nine state boards and committees that advise the Governor, the Legislature and state agencies.

In March, Governor Terry Branstad will make physician appointments to the boards of Athletic Training, Health, Medicine, Physician Assistants, Podiatry, Respiratory Care, and Speech Pathology and Audiology, and to the Medical Assistant Pharmaceutical and Therapeutics Committee and the Rural Health and Primary Care Committee. The appointments require confirmation by the Iowa Senate.
