

## March 12, 1998

At its regular meeting held in Des Moines on March 12, 1998, the Iowa Board of Medical Examiners finalized the disciplinary action taken against the following Iowa licensed physicians:

**Deborah J. Larson, DO**, a 45 year old physician from Scottsdale, Arizona, entered into a Settlement Agreement with the Iowa Board. Dr. Larson was charged with being disciplined by the Arizona State Board of Osteopathic Examiners due to substance abuse problems. The Iowa Board placed Dr. Larson's Iowa medical license on three and one half (3 1/2) years probation as final resolution of this disciplinary matter.

**Mark J. Leding, DO**, a 39 year old physician from Ottumwa, Iowa, entered into a Settlement Agreement with the Iowa Board. Dr. Leding was charged with violating an existing Settlement Agreement, by signing a blank prescription that was later filled out by a patient. Dr. Leding agreed to pay a \$4,000 civil penalty, have his probation order extended by one (1) year and receive a Citation and Warning as final resolution of this disciplinary matter.

**Stephen C. Seltzer, MD**, a 48 year old physician from Albemarle, North Carolina, entered into a Settlement Agreement with the Iowa Board. Dr. Seltzer was charged with being disciplined by the North Carolina Medical Board for having improper relationships with two patients between 1989 and 1995. Dr. Seltzer agreed to pay a \$1,000 civil penalty and receive a Citation and Warning as final resolution of this disciplinary matter. Dr. Seltzer has not practiced in Iowa for several years.

**Jagadamba Kantamneni, MD**, a 48 year old physician from Keokuk, Iowa, entered into a combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement with the Iowa Board. Dr. Kantamneni was charged with prescribing controlled substances without performing an appropriate examination and failing to maintain an adequate medical record. Dr. Kantamneni agreed to pay a \$1,000 civil penalty and received a Citation and Warning as final resolution of this matter.

**Dawood Siroospour, MD**, a 59 year old physician from Keokuk, Iowa, entered into a combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement with the Iowa Board. Dr. Siroospour was charged with prescribing controlled substances without performing an appropriate examination and failing to maintain an adequate medical record. Dr. Siroospour agreed to pay a \$1,000 civil penalty and received a Citation and Warning as final resolution of this matter.

**James K. Killian, DO**, a 36 year old physician from Johnston, Iowa, entered into a combined Statement of Charges, Settlement Agreement and Final Order with the Iowa Board. Dr. Killian was charged with violating an existing Settlement Agreement, by resuming the use of alcohol. The Iowa Board indefinitely suspended Dr. Killian's Iowa medical license.

In other action, the Board authorized the issuance of a permanent Iowa medical license under the terms and conditions of a consent agreement to the following physician.

**William J. Bussey, MD**, a Colorado licensed physician practicing in emergency medicine, received an Iowa medical license under the terms and conditions of a consent agreement. The terms of the agreement prohibit Dr. Bussey from using alcohol or other controlled substances not prescribed by a qualified treating health care provider. The agreement also requires Dr. Bussey to seek continuing substance abuse treatment, file regular reports on his progress and provide blood or urine specimens on demand.
