## Governor announces Board appointments: Drew, Snyder, Stockdale, Vista-Wayne

DES MOINES, IA – Governor Chet Culver and Lieutenant Governor Patty Judge have announced four appointments to the Iowa Board of Medicine. The appointees will begin their three-year terms effective May 1, pending confirmation by the Iowa Senate.

Tom Drew of Des Moines, Jeffrey Snyder, M.D., of Crescent and Colleen Stockdale, M.D., of Muscatine were reappointed for a second term on the Board. Joyce Vista-Wayne, M.D., of Ottumwa was appointed to the Board to fill a seat being vacated by Yasyn Lee, M.D., of Dubuque, who is completing her service to the Board.

Vista-Wayne, board-certified in child and adolescent and adult psychiatry, practices at the Ottumwa Regional Health Center. She has been a member of the Iowa Physician Health Committee for six years and was elected chairperson of the committee in December 2009. The committee administers a Board program to offer support to physicians who self-report problems with mental health issues, physical disability, or drug and alcohol problems.

Drew, an attorney, joined the Board May 1, 2007. He serves on the Executive and Licensure committees.

Snyder, a board-certified emergency room physician at Mercy Hospital in Council Bluffs, joined the Board May 1, 2008. He serves on the Monitoring and Screening committees.

Stockdale, a board-certified obstetrician and gynecologist at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics, Iowa City, joined the Board October 12, 2007. She serves on the Executive and Licensure committees.

The 10-member Iowa Board of Medicine is appointed by the governor to license and regulate physicians and acupuncturists in Iowa. The Board is composed of seven physicians and three public members.
