Michael Thompson, D.O., called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m. A roll call was taken to establish the presence of a quorum.

Mark Bowden, Executive Director, provided a brief report to the Board:

- The Senate Human Resources Committee has approved legislation that would deem a an active license relinquished after 5 years and to issue an administrative medical license.
- A House Human Resources subcommittee is working on legislation to update Iowa Code Section 148E (acupuncture).
- The interstate medical licensure compact legislation is moving through the Senate but it is still in subcommittee in the House. The compact has been adopted by legislatures in Wyoming, Idaho and Utah. It has been introduced in 15 other states.
- Governor Branstad has appointed Mary Romanco, Pleasantville, Kyle Ulveling, M.D., Carroll, and Charles Wadle, D.O., West Des Moines, to the Board, effective May 1. They will succeed Frank Bognanno, Julie Perkins, M.D., and Michael Thompson, D.O., who

are not seeking reappointment when their terms expire April 30. An orientation will be held in April for the new Board members.

At 7:33 a.m. on a motion by Julie Carmody, M.D., and a second by Diane Cortese, the Board voted to meet in closed session pursuant to Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(f) to consider a temporary licensure application for Francesco Catellani, M.D., and to consider a temporary licensure application for Jorge Mario Morales Valencia, M.D., and to consider the request for approval of a new practice settings for Ryan D. Lee, D.O., File No. 03-2010-546. Those voting in favor of the motion to meet in closed session were Frank Bognanno, Julie Carmody, M.D., Diane Clark, Diane Cortese, Julie Perkins, M.D., and Michael Thompson, D.O.

At 7:45 a.m. on a motion by Julie Carmody, M.D., seconded by Frank Bognanno, the Board voted unanimously to move to open session.

At 7:45 a.m., on a motion by Julie Carmody, M.D., seconded by Diane Clark, the Board voted to grant a temporary license to Jorge Mario Morales Valencia, M.D. Frank Bognanno, Diane Cortese, Julie Perkins, M.D., and Michael Thompson, D.O., all voted “aye” in favor of the motion.

At 7:45 a.m., on a motion by Julie Carmody, M.D., seconded by Frank Bognanno, the Board voted to approve the request for approval of new practice setting for Ryan D. Lee, D.O., File No. 03-2010-546. Diane Clark, Diane Cortese, Julie Perkins, M.D., and Michael Thompson, D.O., all voted “aye” in favor of the motion.
