**653—14.7 Terms of participation.** A participant shall agree to comply with the terms for participation in the IPHP established in the initial agreement and contract.

**653—14.7(2) “a” First instance.** Upon receiving notification of a first instance of significant noncompliance including, but not limited to, a relapse, the Iowa Physician Health Committee (IPHC) shall make a report to the board which identifies the participant by IPHP case number, describes the relevant terms of the participant’s contract and the noncompliance, and includes the IPHC’s recommendation as to whether the participant should remain in the program. Upon receiving the report, the board shall determine if formal disciplinary charges should be filed, pursuant to 653—subrule 23.1(12).
