**(May 22, 2019)**

Recently, the Iowa Board of Medicine took the following action:

**Melissa S. Loseke, D.O.**, a 39-year-old physician who practices medicine in Omaha, Nebraska, entered into a Consent Agreement with the Board on May 20, 2019. On May 1, 2017, Dr. Loseke entered into a Consent Order with the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (Kansas Board). The Kansas Board alleged that Dr. Loseke provided injections and Vampire Facelift procedure(s) on eight separate occasions to patients in Overland Park, Kansas, when she was not licensed in the State of Kansas to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in violation of the laws and rules governing the practice of osteopathic medicine and surgery in Kansas. The Kansas Board temporarily suspended Dr. Loseke's Kansas medical license until she successfully completed a Board-approved professional ethics program, issued her a public censure and ordered her to pay a \$1,000 fine. Dr. Loseke has fully complied with the terms of the Consent Order she entered into with the Kansas Board. Under the terms of the May 20, 2019, Consent Agreement, the Iowa Board granted Dr. Loseke an Iowa medical license and issued her Citation and Warning for being disciplined by the Kansas Board.

**When appropriate, disciplinary actions are reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank, an electronic repository administered by the U.S. Health Resources and Services Administration to track adverse license actions.**
