Kyle Ulveling, M.D., Board Chair, called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m. The roll was read and all members were present with the exception of Diane Cortese, Board Secretary.

On a motion by Joyce Vista-Wayne, M.D., seconded by Mary Jo Romano, the Board voted to **approve** the agenda as presented.

The first item on the agenda was to consider a request for an Application to Stay filed on behalf of Dominico Cacaterra, M.D., File No. 02-2011-077.
