At 7:32 a.m., Kyle Ulveling, M.D., Chair, called the meeting to order. Roll call was taken.

At 7:33 a.m., on a motion by Kyle Ulveling, M.D, seconded by Mary Jo Romanco, all members present voted to approve the agenda.

On a motion by Joyce Vista-Wayne, M.D, seconded by Nikhil Wagle, M.D., all members present voted to meet in closed session, pursuant to Iowa Code Sections 21.5(1)(a), 21.5(1)(d) and 21.5(1)(f), to review or discuss records which are required or authorized by state or federal law to be kept confidential, discuss the contents of a licensing examination or whether to initiate licensee disciplinary investigations or proceedings, and discuss the decision to be rendered in a contested case. Kyle Ulveling, M.D., Diane Cortese, Warren Gall, M.D., Mary Jo Romanco, Joyce Vista-Wayne, M.D., Nikhil Wagle, M.D., and Brian Wilson, D.O., all voted aye in a roll call vote to approve the motion.

At 7:50 a.m., while still in closed session, all members present voted in favor of a motion by Kyle Ulveling, M.D., seconded by Joyce Vista-Wayne, M.D., to meet in an open session. In open session, the Board took the following actions:

- 1. On a motion by Joyce Vista Wayne, M.D., seconded by Warren Gall, M.D., the Board voted to leave the file open for further investigation regarding file 02-2019-100.**

2. On a motion by Warren Gall, M.D., seconded by Nikhil Wagle, M.D., the Board voted to accept the Combined Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement for Scott Nau, M.D., file 02-2019-075.
3. On a motion by Joyce Vista Wayne, M.D., seconded by Warren Gall, M.D., the Board voted to close with no action the investigative report regarding file 02-2020-016.
4. On a motion by Joyce Vista Wayne, M.D., seconded by Nikhil Wagle, M.D., the Board voted to close with no action the investigative report regarding file 02-2020-077.
5. Discussion to consider postponing enforcement of evaluation orders due to COVID-19 - to avoid in-person contact and due to financial concerns for physicians who have stopped practicing.
6. Chuck Hurley, attorney for The Family Leader was on the public call in line to express his concern about abortions still being performed when the Governor's Proclamation ordered against it.

Mr. Nebel, Executive Director for the Board, informed Mr. Hurley that the Board has issued one cease and desist order and will review following complaints on a case by case basis.
